

1st Presbyterian Church, Bailieborough, or Corglass Presbyterian

Baptisms 1861 – 1983; Marriages 1845 – 1955; Burials *none listed* [PRONI MIC/1P/145]

The present church was built in 1795 on the site of an older one. It became known as the “Patriot Church” because so many of its members fought at the Battle of Rebel Hill during the 1798 rebellion (800 died at Rebel Hill). Rev Thomas Byers (son of an elder of Bellasis) was minister here from 1921 to 1924.
