Thomas **Byers**, Cliffin, Killinkere, Virginia, Co. Cavan, Private, 5<sup>th</sup> Battalion, Canadian Infantry (Saskatchewan Regiment). Killed in action, 2 June 1916. Age 20. Son of James and Ellen Byers.

The Killinkere Church Records include details of those who paid into the Sustenation Fund

John **Byers** contributed 10s.0d in 1884/5/6/7/8/9, 1890, apparently not in 1891, then 1892, 10s.6d in 1893, 10s.0d in 1894/5/6/7/8/9 and 1900

Dr William **Byers** contributed £2.0.0 in 1888 /9, 1890, £2.2.0 in 1891/2, apparently not in 1893, £2.0.0 in 1894 ... then apparently nothing until £1.0.0 in 1899 and 10s.0d in 1900 when he was listed as Wm. **Byers** M.D.
