Robert Johnston(e)'s parents were probably Arthur and Maria Johnston of Lissanymore. Robert was born before the surviving church baptismal register ... but there were at least two younger sisters. Details to be discovered!

So, if ages are accepted as accurate (always a dubious assumption!):

Jane **Johnston**, formerly Jane **Byers** (née **McIlwaine**), was born c.1838 She would have married Robert Byers when she was c.33/34 Robert Johnston was born c.1842

... and Robert Byers died in 1877 aged 44 (born c.1833).

The witness at the wedding of Jane McIlwaine and Robert Byers was Mary Anne Byers. In 1884 at Bellasis Presb. Church, a Mary Anne Byers married James Byers. Both their fathers were called Robert Byers. She lived at Aghalohan and just possibly was the daughter of my family's Robert Byers by his first marriage. This might help trace him back.
